

CODE OF CONDUCT – CONFERENCE OF YOUNG ALASKANS 2009

DELEGATES TO COYA 2009 AGREE TO

- Participate actively in proceedings of the Conference of Young Alaskans 2009
- Abide by the expectations and provisions established in this document, the letter of acceptance, and the acknowledgement of risks and release of liability document
- Refrain from unacceptable behavior, examples of which include:
 - Leaving one's own hotel room after curfew
 - Drinking alcohol or using illicit drugs
 - Engaging in inappropriate sexual activity
 - Disrupting the conference or the hotel
- Expect a zero-tolerance response to breaking the standards of behavior required of delegates

RESULTS OF UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

Upon receiving a credible report of significant misbehavior by a delegate, Information Insights staff will coordinate with the Steering Committee to investigate and determine whether the delegate can continue to participate in COYA. In the event a delegate must leave the conference for breaking the conduct agreement, Information Insights will identify a responsible individual to drive the delegate to the airport or to an agreed location in the Municipality of Anchorage. The delegate will be responsible for all fees involved in returning home immediately (i.e. canceled hotel, travel to Anchorage or to the airport, change fee for air travel, meals, etc.).
